ACKERMAN FAMILY VINEYARDS

Founded in 1994 after purchasing the 15.5 acre “Stonehaven” property in Napa’s up-and-coming Coombsville district. The following year, the first experimental wine was produced, and, in 2003, the company produced its first commercial wine, a Cabernet Sauvignon from the Stonehaven Estate. In 2009, AFV became the first certified organic vineyard in the Coombsville AVA. Today, Ackerman Family Vineyards produces an estate-grown 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, in addition to Memoir, a Bordeaux style blend, Alavigna Tosca, a Cabernet Sauvignon and Sangiovese blend and Sauvignon Blanc.



VINTAGE

Minimal rainfall during the growing season, about 14 inches, produced slightly lighter crops but brought intense, concentrated flavor and color. The first part of the year was cold and dry followed by consistent weather during the summer months helping to maintain fruit acidity for brightness and balance.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Sauvignon Blanc has a gorgeous nose of grapefruit, Granny Smith apple, Kadota fig, fresh lime peel and lemon juice aromas. The medium bodied palate is clean and fresh, with mouthwatering acidity, rounded texture, and a refreshing finish.

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VINTAGE

2018 was a beautiful long and cool vintage with no real intense heat waves, which allowed the fruit to mature evenly and gracefully. The wines show a beautiful sense of freshness and purity, and at times can have an almost Bordeaux-like character in their tannins, acids, and textures. This vintage has all the components for wines to be enjoyed now or age for decades to come.

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VINIFICATION & TASTING NOTES

Harvested mid-October, 4-5 days cold soak, 9-14 days of primary fermentation in stainless steel tanks and malolactic fermentation took place in the barrel. Barrels are composed of 100% French oak and 65% new from Baron, Atelier Center of France, Slyvain, Ermitage & Boutes, 90% medium toast & 10% medium plus toasted.

Full-bodied, flawlessly balanced, and both powerful and elegant. It offers a beautiful bouquet of freshly crushed blackberries, blackcurrants and black raspberries plus a touch of lavender and warm spices like toasted vanilla and brioche. It has fine-grained tannins and tons of freshness, finishing long and minerally.

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VINTAGE & VINIFICATION

The 2019 growing season consisted of copious rainfall and late soil moisture. The long, warm summer saw few extreme heat events with foggy mornings setting the stage for vibrant and expressive wines. The long, relatively mild finish to the season, preserved the freshness and finesse in the fruit.

The 2019 Memoir is predominantly Cabernet based with an additional portion of 4 Bordeaux varieties aged in 65% new French Oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 vintage is a medium to full-bodied wine, bold but elegant. It jumps out of the glass with fresh blueberries, plum preserves, and blackberry compote plus hints of dark chocolate, toasted vanilla, and spices. Velvety tannins and tons of freshness.

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VINIFICATION & TASTING NOTES

Harvested late October, 4-5 days cold soak, 9-14 days of primary fermentation in stainless steel tanks and malolactic fermentation took place in the barrel. 75% medium toast & 25% medium plus toast barrel composition. The cooperages selected were Tonnellerie Baron, preserves the vibrant fruit and adds a hint of sweetness on finish, & Tonnellerie Sylvain, supple tannins elegant mid palate and lingering finish.

A deep mulberry complexion with dark fruit aromatics of blackberries, blackcurrants and warm blueberries with touches of dark chocolate and toasted vanilla. On the palate, it has a medium to full-bodied mouthfeel with firm, youthful tannins, great structure, plenty of freshness and a long lasting finish.

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VINTAGE & VINIFICATION

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We harvest the Estate Vineyard in 3 different maturity levels. The first pick was at the top of the vineyard, which provides lower yields and smaller berries at the end of September. The following pick was the middle of the vineyard on the 2nd week of October and our last pick was the 3rd week of October. This allowed them to pick sections of the vineyard when it was physiological mature. We began with a cold soak, then fermented all-in stainless-steel tanks. Then the wine was transferred in French oak barrels where we aged for 20 months.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Cabernet has bright blue fruits, cassis, graphite, toast, crème burlee and mineral notes. It is a full bodied, concentrated, yet elegant that has ripe tannins, a great mid-palate and a great long-lasting finish. This wine is brilliant, balanced, seamless and truly showcases the qualities of what makes Coombsville unique and great.



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VINTAGE & VINIFICATION

Ackerman Family Vineyards was fortunate to source Sangiovese fruit from atop of Atlas Peak AVA from Antica which is at 1,700 feet of elevation. This vineyard and estate is owned by an Italian family (the Antinori’s) who have been in the wine industry since 1385. Sangiovese is one of the first red grapes we harvest, it’s fermented in stainless steel and made with gentler winemaking techniques, shorter pump overs, 5 days of cold soaks, fermentation starts soon after which took 14 days. The wine is then transferred to once use Bordeaux barrels where we aged it for 20 months. The composition of the Alavigna Tosca is 60% Sangiovese and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon from our Coombsville Estate Vineyard.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 vintage sports a medium ruby color, with a nose of warm spices like warm vanilla and clove, dried flowers, and baking spice. About as seamless and silky as they come on the palate, it has a beautifully integrated acidity, and a great finish.

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

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TASTING NOTES & VINIFICATION

A Sangiovese dominate wine of 60%, and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon from our Coombsville Estate. This wine is medium in weight with bright red fruit notes of cherries, raspberries, vanilla and spice.

This wine is fermented separately. The Sangiovese is grown on Atlas Peak AVA and it tends to ripen in late September. It is aged in 100% twice filled French Oak barrels, then Cabernet is added to it in small increments at our blending sessions. We as a team like to have the Sangiovese shine through and have the Cabernet give it concentration and depth. This wine is approachable in its youth but also can age like Cabernet.

VINTAGE

2021 was an ideal vintage compared to the previous vintage where we had wild fires. Moderate rain in the fall that transitioned to a warm spring. The summer months was warm with no real heat spikes, which allowed the fruit to ripen in early to mid October. We started harvesting with our Sangiovese on top of Atlas Peak, then our spice block, finished with our Cabernet. Although our yields were the lowest in recent years, the quality was exceptional. This vintage is approachable upon release but also has great aging potential. Unfortunately, not much wine was produce in this vintage due to historically low rain fall, yet the quality is exceptional.
